- Comply with Ethical Supplier Threshold requirements of the Queensland Procurement Policy
- Reduce long-term and youth unemployment by delivering jobs and increasing apprenticeships
- Increase opportunities for apprentices by adhering to the Queensland Government Building and Construction Training Policy
- Create training and employment opportunities, particularly for disadvantaged or marginalised jobseekers such as people with disability
- Consider workplace policies and practices aimed at addressing domestic and family violence
- Support diversity in the supply market by generating opportunities for small and regional businesses, social enterprises and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander businesses
- Support purchase of textile, clothing or footwear products from ethical manufacturers and suppliers where possible
- Procure paper products that comply with the relevant standard under the Australian Forest Certification scheme
- Avoid engaging in 'dumped' goods
