

Your invitation to attend a community information drop-in session in Greenbank

Wednesday 30 August 4–7pm

CS Energy and Powerlink are hosting a local community information drop-in session for the Greenbank Battery Energy Storage System project, being constructed adjacent to the existing Greenbank Substation on Pub Lane.

As a community member within the project area, we encourage you to come along to this session and ask any questions you may have about the battery and upcoming works on the project. There is no presentation – simply drop in when it suits you.

CS Energy is developing a large-scale battery on Powerlink-owned land, adjacent to the existing substation. When operational, the battery will provide a reliable, fast-start electricity supply into the electricity grid during periods of peak demand.

Site mobilisation is expected to commence in early September. Construction activities will be undertaken between 6.30am and 6.30pm, Monday to Saturday, and traffic controls will be in place to manage the small volume of additional construction-related traffic.



We thank the local community in advance for your patience and cooperation while works are being undertaken. We will continue to keep you informed of our activities and look forward to meeting you at our community information session.
