Bouldercombe to Larcom Creek Transmission Line Reinforcement Project

Dear resident,

Powerlink is continuing planning and design activities for the Bouldercombe to Larcom Creek Transmission Line Reinforcement Project. We are writing to provide you with information on upcoming field work required for the project.



UPCOMING FIELD INVESTIGATIONS

From this month, a range of field investigations are expected to take place to help inform project design and planning. These studies include:

- visual amenity assessments
- traffic impact assessments
- geotechnical investigations
- cadastral surveys
- cultural heritage surveys.

These studies will provide important information about land conditions and cultural heritage values.



WHAT TO EXPECT

On-ground requirements will vary depending on the study. For visual amenity assessments and cadastral surveys, you may briefly see teams wearing high-visibility clothing in public areas, alongside roads and within Powerlink easements.

Geotechnical investigations will involve collecting core samples to assess ground and soil conditions. This work will typically use a drill rig, either truck-mounted or track-mounted, depending on the terrain. A support vehicle, usually a small water cart, will also be used. Each borehole will take about one day to complete.

Field activities will generally take place between 6.30am and 6.30pm, Monday to Friday, subject to weather conditions.



WORKING WITH LANDHOLDERS

Powerlink recognises the importance of protecting land, livestock and agricultural operations. All studies will be undertaken in accordance with property-specific access, biosecurity and safety requirements. Where access to private property is required, Powerlink will contact impacted landholders directly to discuss the proposed works and agree on access arrangements before any field activities commence.

We thank landholders for their patience and understanding while this important work takes place.
