NOTIFICATION OF UPCOMING WORKS – CONTROL BUILDING DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION

Dear resident,

We are writing to advise you of upcoming works near your property as part of Powerlink's Ingham South Substation Reinvestment Project.



CONTROL BUILDING DELIVERY AND INSTALLATION

Works to upgrade critical equipment at the Ingham South Substation started in early August 2026 and are progressing well.

These works include a new control building which is expected to be delivered to the substation site in **mid-to-late October 2026**.

Pilot vehicles and traffic management will be in place to assist with delivery of the 14-metre-long building. Cranes will also be used to install the building on-site.

Access to your property will be maintained at all times, and our work crews will use existing roads and access tracks wherever practicable.

The new control building has been designed to Q200 flood levels and will help monitor, protect and control the continued safe and reliable operation of the substation.



ONGOING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Construction activities will continue at the substation site until **mid-December 2026**.

Various machinery will be used including forklifts, excavators, cranes and other heavy vehicles.

As some construction activities may take up to 12 hours and must continue once they start, work crews will be on-site between **6am and 6pm, seven days a week**.

We will work to minimise noise and dust from our activities wherever possible, including by limiting some construction activities on Sundays and watering work areas and access tracks.

The upgrade works are scheduled to resume in **April 2027**, and we will provide you with an update on timings before any activities start next year.

We greatly appreciate your ongoing patience as we deliver these important works.



PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Ingham South Substation is an important part of Powerlink's 132kV transmission network helping to supply electricity to the wider Ingham area and Ergon Energy's 66kV Ingham Substation.

Construction works are required at our Ingham South Substation to upgrade critical equipment, install the new control building designed to Q200 flood levels and ensure a safe, secure and reliable electricity supply into the future.

The project is being delivered in stages over three years with works expected to be completed by **November 2028** (weather dependent).

The works will not result in any planned electricity outages, and all construction activities will be undertaken on Powerlink-owned land. We will keep you updated on works and timings as the project progresses.
